His inspirational approach to leadership development resulted in him being given Embercombe, a 50-acre Devonshire smallholding, by an appreciative client to develop his vision: a social enterprise which seeks ‘to inspire committed action for a truly sustainable world’

Wendy Stephenson is a member of the Forum 21 steering committee and has been engaged in climate change strategy both as a profession and volunteer. She was the chair of the manufacturers’ climate change group based in Westminster representing UK manufacturing and specifically UK Steel on climate change issues. This experience extended to proposed policy on international engagement beyond Kyoto. Wendy continues to provide advice to a range of organisations on climate change issues and has launched the West Somerset Carbon Reinvestment Scheme.

Steve is well known nationally and internationally for his work in team work and case management in mental health. He now works more widely as a solution focused coach, facilitator, team developer and researcher (see www.steveonyett.co.uk) and has a background in clinical psychology. His many associations include work as a Senior Development Consultant for the South West Development Centre, a Leadership Development Associate with the Kings Fund, and Visiting Professor at the University of the West of England. He has held a wide range of clinical, research and management roles and has published widely, including “Teamworking in Mental Health”. Steve co-edits the International Journal of Leadership in Public Services and led the national “Developing Effective Leadership for Social Inclusion” initiative within the National Social Inclusion Programme.
